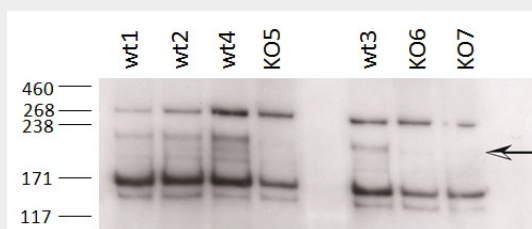

AF3614a (0.05 µg/ml) staining of Rat Brain lysate (35 µg protein in RIPA buffer). Primary incubation was 1 hour. Detected by chemiluminescence.
