Format

Liquid. Purified antibody supplied in 1x PBS buffer with 0.09% (w/v) sodium azide and 2% sucrose.

Reconstitution & Storage

Add 50 ul of distilled water. Final anti-UBN1 antibody concentration is 1 mg/ml in PBS buffer with 2% sucrose. For longer periods of storage, store at 20°C. Avoid repeat freeze-thaw cycles.

Name UBN1

Function

Acts as a novel regulator of senescence. Involved in the formation of senescence-associated heterochromatin foci (SAHF), which represses expression of proliferation-promoting genes. Binds to proliferation-promoting genes. May be required for replication- independent chromatin assembly.

Cellular Location

Nucleus, nucleoplasm. Nucleus, PML body. Cell junction, tight junction. Note=Localized as a



nuclear speckled-like pattern in proliferating primary fibroblasts. Colocalizes with HIRA, PML and SP100 in PML bodies of senescent cells. Colocalizes with TJP1 and CLDN1. Detected along the upper granular cell layer of epidermis When overexpressed, accumulates in the nucleus in cells showing defective cytokinesis

Tissue Location


Ubiquitous. Also expressed in numerous tumors and cancer cell lines.
