Detected in the majority of epithelial cells in tumor and normal tissues. Expressed also in human umbilical vein endothelial cells.

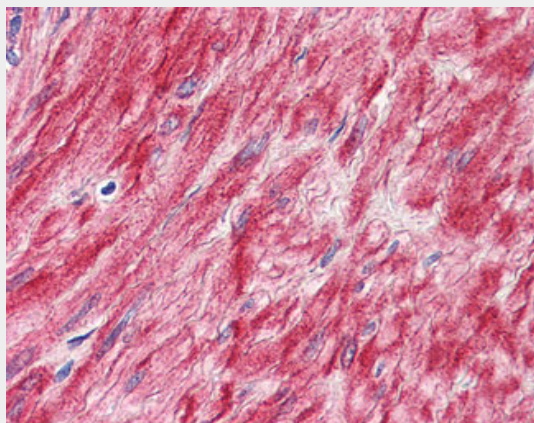
