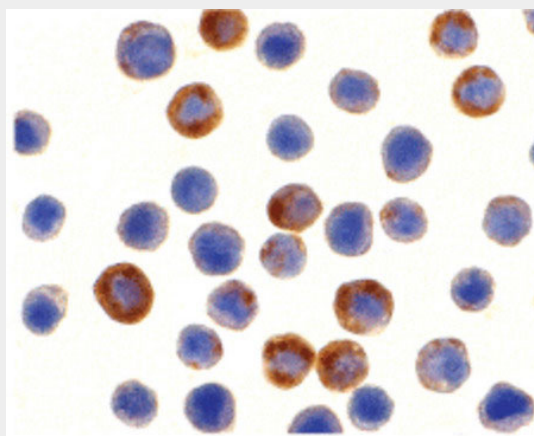

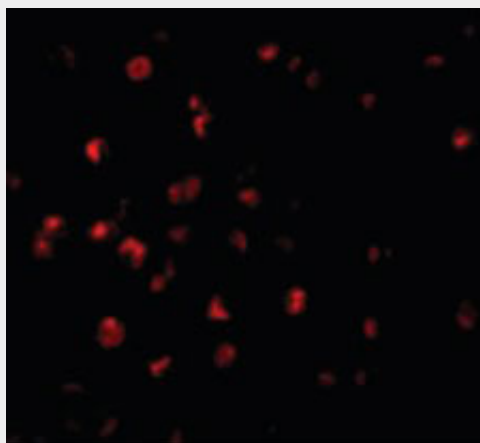

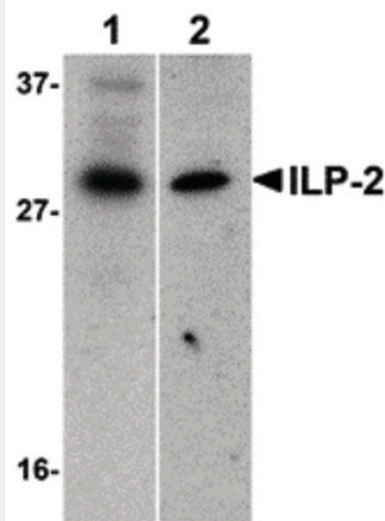

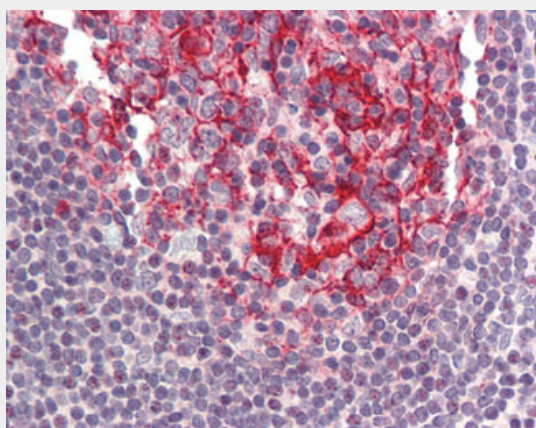
Immunocytochemistry of ILP-2 in HepG2 cells with ILP-2 antibody at 10 ug/ml.
