Tissue Location

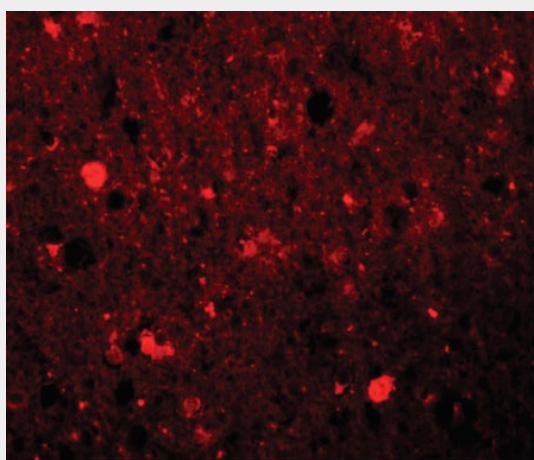

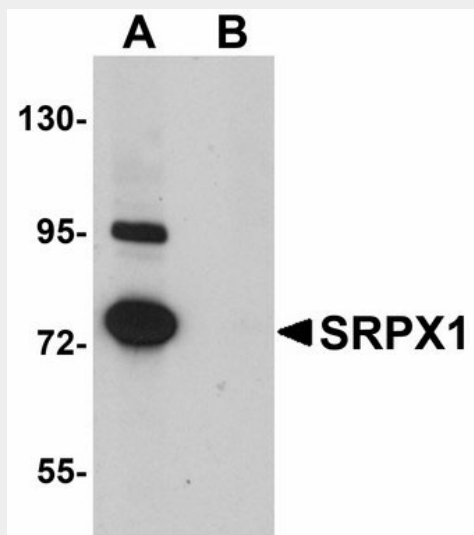

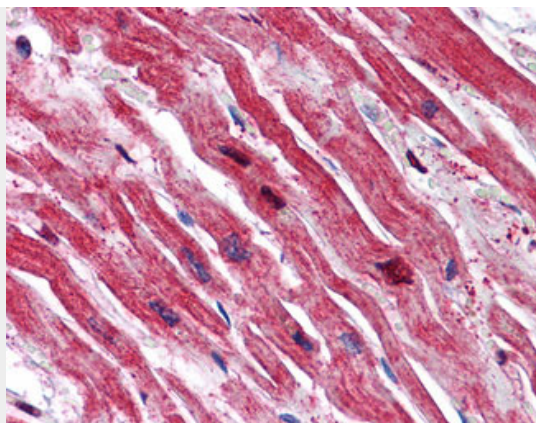
