Interferon (IFN)-inducible GTPase that plays important roles in innate immunity against a diverse range of bacterial, viral and protozoan pathogens (By similarity). Negatively regulates the antiviral response by inhibiting activation of IRF7 transcription factor (By similarity).

Cellular Location

Golgi apparatus membrane. Cytoplasm Nucleus. Cytoplasm, perinuclear region.

Note=Heterodimers with GBP1, GBP2 and GBP5 localize in the compartment of the prenylated GBPs: with GBP1 in a vesicle-like compartment, with GBP2, around the nucleus and with GBP5, at the Golgi apparatus.

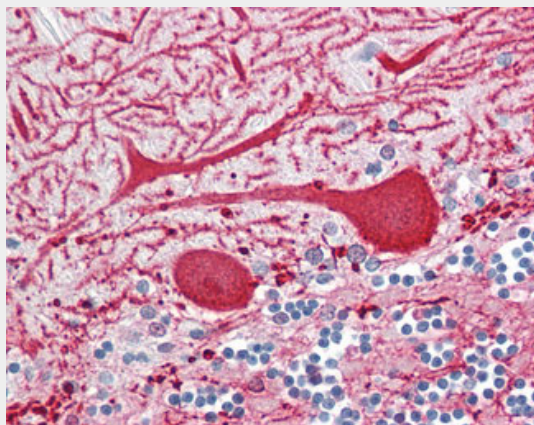

GBP4 / Mpa2 Antibody (aa551-600) - Background

Binds GTP, GDP and GMP. Hydrolyzes GTP very efficiently; GDP rather than GMP is the major reaction product. Plays a role in erythroid differentiation (By similarity).
