Induces ARHGEF7 activity on RAC1 as well as lamellipodia and membrane ruffle formation (PubMed:16959763). In neurons, regulates spine maturation through the modulation of ARHGEF7 activity (By similarity).

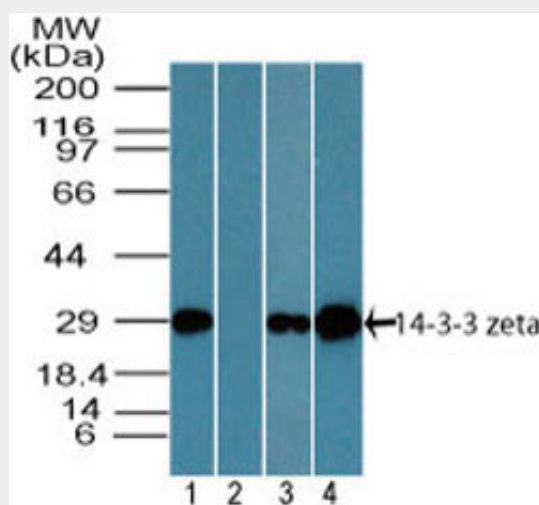
Cytoplasm. Melanosome. Note=Located to stage I to stage IV melanosomes.
