PBS, pH 7.4, 0.02% sodium azide, 50% glycerol. Store frozen product at or below -20°C. Thawed product may be stored for 2-4 weeks at 4°C. For optimal storage, aliquot to smaller portions and store at -20°C to -70°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

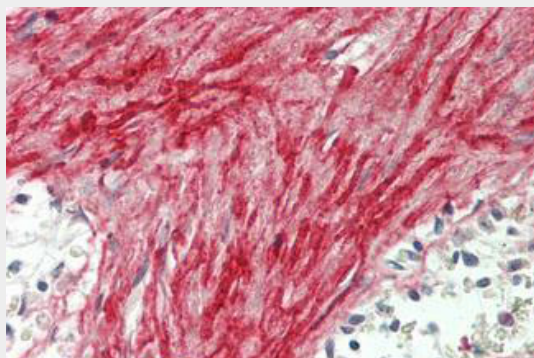

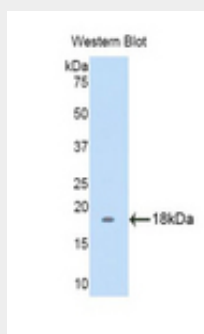
