Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

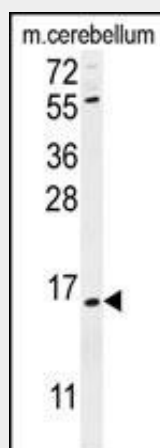

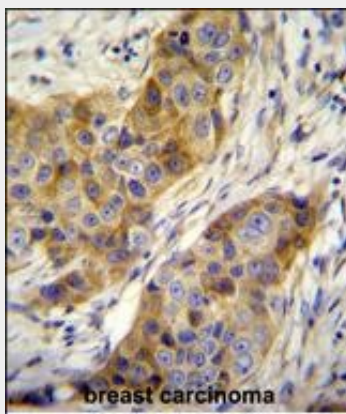

ANR39 Antibody (C-term) (Cat. #AP11153b) western blot analysis in mouse cerebellum tissue lysates (35ug/lane). This demonstrates the ANR39 antibody detected the ANR39 protein (arrow).



ANR39 Antibody (C-term) (Cat. #AP11153b) immunohistochemistry analysis in formalin fixed and paraffin embedded human breast carcinoma followed by peroxidase conjugation of the secondary antibody and DAB staining.
