Target/Specificity

This SIDT1 antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 412-441 amino acids from the Central region of human SIDT1.

Dilution

Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

SIDT1 Antibody (Center) - Protein Information**Name** SIDT1

Function In vitro binds long double-stranded RNA (dsRNA) (500 and 700 base pairs), but not dsRNA shorter than 300 bp. Not involved in RNA autophagy, a process in which RNA is directly imported into lysosomes in an ATP-dependent manner, and degraded.

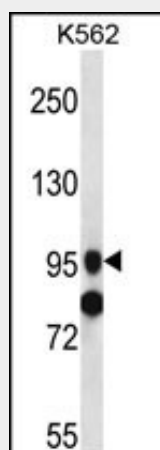
