This Evx2 antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 444-475 amino acids from the C-terminal region of human Evx2.

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

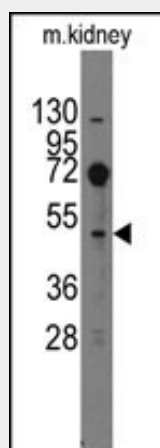

Western blot analysis of anti-Evx2 Pab (Cat.#AP1427b) in mouse kidney tissue lysates (35ug/lane). Evx2 (arrow) was detected using the purified Pab.

Evx2 Antibody (C-term) - Background

Evx-2, a protein related to the Drosophila even-skipped (eve), is expressed in limbs like the neighbouring Hoxd genes. Evx-2 functions like a Hoxd gene.
