This IP6K3 antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 72-98 amino acids from the N-terminal region of human IP6K3.

Dilution

WB~~1:1000

Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

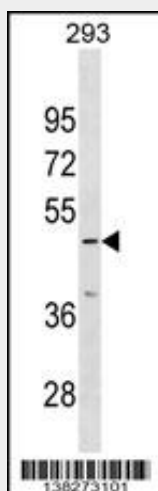

IP6K3 Antibody (N-term) (Cat. #AP17979a) western blot analysis in 293 cell line lysates (35ug/lane). This demonstrates the IP6K3 antibody detected the IP6K3 protein (arrow).

IP6K3 Antibody (N-term) - Background

This gene encodes a protein that belongs to the inositol phosphokinase (IPK) family. This protein is likely responsible for the conversion of inositol hexakisphosphate (InsP6) to diphosphoinositol pentakisphosphate (InsP7/PP-InsP5). It may also convert 1,3,4,5,6-pentakisphosphate (InsP5) to PP-InsP4. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants encoding the same protein.
