**Target/Specificity**

This ZNF768 antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 3-29 amino acids from the N-terminal region of human ZNF768.

**Dilution**

WB~~1:1000

**Format**

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

**Storage**

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

**Function** Binds to mammalian-wide interspersed repeat (MIRs) sequences in euchromatin and promoter regions of genes at the consensus sequence 5'-GCTGTGTG-[N20]-CCTCTCTG-3',

consisting of two anchor regions connected by a linker region; the linker region probably does not contribute to the binding specificity (PubMed:[30476274](#)). Required for cell homeostasis (PubMed:[34404770](#)). May be involved in transcriptional regulation (Probable).

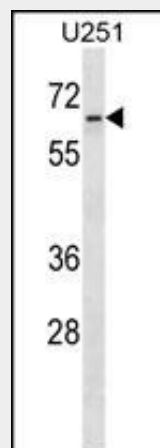
Nucleus. Chromosome. Note=Localizes to euchromatin
