Cytoplasm. Rough endoplasmic reticulum. Note=Localizes exclusively with the rough endoplasmic reticulum (RER)**Tissue Location**
Widely expressed. Expressed in brain, pancreas, heart, skeletal muscles, liver, lung, kidney and placenta
