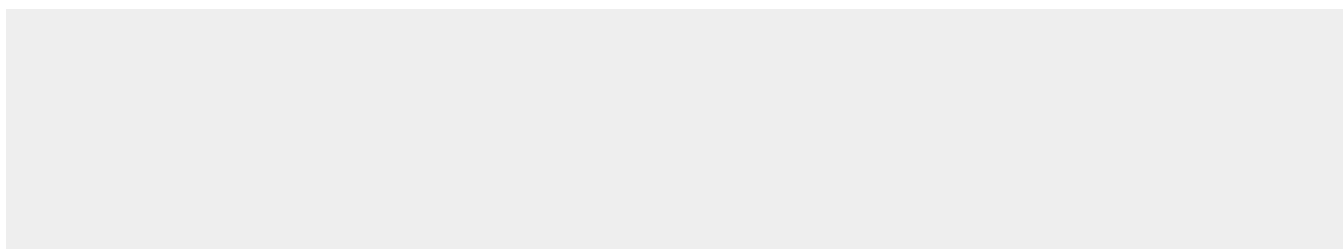

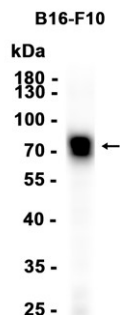

TYRP1 (7011) Rabbit Monoclonal Antibody - Background
