# **Shipping Condition**

### **Purity**

This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using Rabbit IgG coupled to agarose beads followed by solid phase adsorption(s) to remove any unwanted reactivities. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Alkaline Phosphatase (calf intestine), anti-Guinea Pig Serum, Rabbit IgG and Rabbit Serum. No reaction was observed against Goat, Human and Mouse Serum Proteins.

## **Storage Condition**

Store vial at 4° C before opening. DO NOT FREEZE. This product is stable at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use. Freezing alkaline phosphatase conjugates will result in a substantial loss of enzymatic activity.

This product is for research use only and is not intended for therapeutic or diagnostic applications.



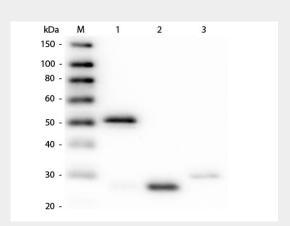

Western Blot of Anti-Rabbit IgG (H&L) (GUINEA PIG) Antibody (Min X Hu, Gt, Ms Serum Proteins). Lane M: 3 µl Molecular Ladder. Lane 1: Rabbit IgG whole molecule . Lane 2: Rabbit IgG F(ab) Fragment . Lane 3: Rabbit IgG F(c) Fragment . All samples were reduced. Load: 50 ng per lane. Block: MB-070 for 30 min at RT. Primary Antibody: Anti-Rabbit IgG (H&L) (GUINEA PIG) Antibody (Min X Hu, Gt, Ms Serum Proteins) 1:500 for 60 min at RT. Secondary antibody: Anti-Guinea Pig IgG (GOAT) Peroxidase Conjugated Antibody 1:40,000 in MB-070 for 30 min at RT. Predicted/Obsevered Size: 25 and 50 kDa for Rabbit IgG and Serum, 25 kDa for F(c) and F(ab). Rabbit F(c) migrates slightly higher.
