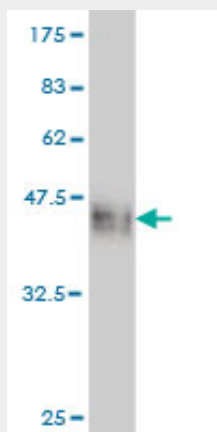

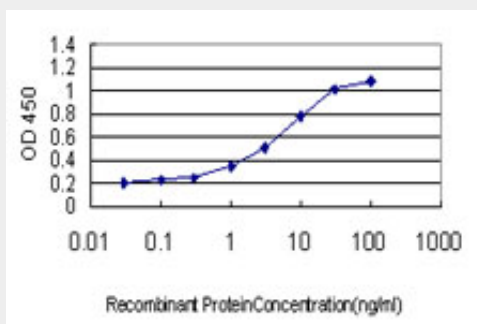

Detection limit for recombinant GST tagged CDX4 is approximately 0.1ng/ml as a capture antibody.
