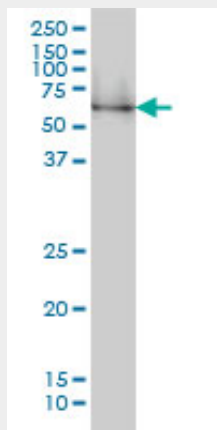

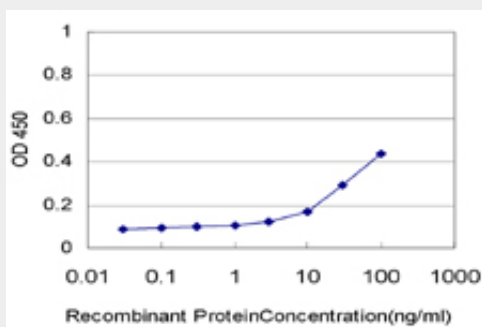

Detection limit for recombinant GST tagged NRBP1 is approximately 1ng/ml as a capture antibody.
