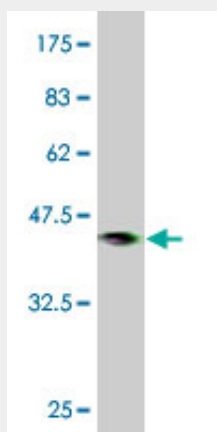

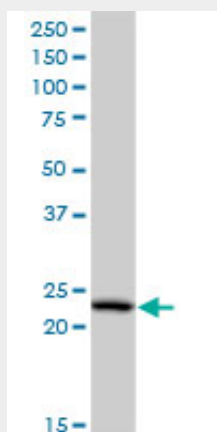

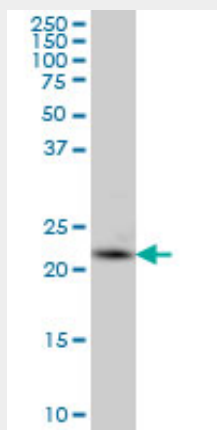

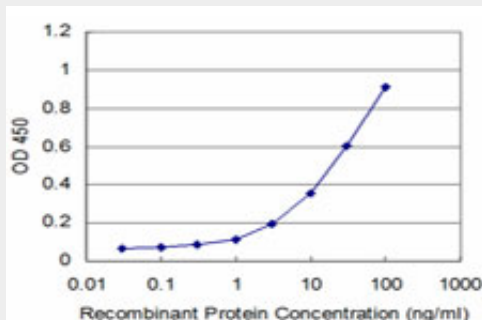
Antibody Reactive Against Recombinant Protein. Western Blot detection against Immunogen (37.73 kDa) .
