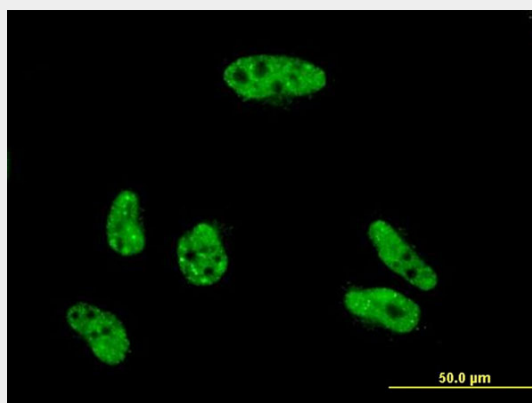

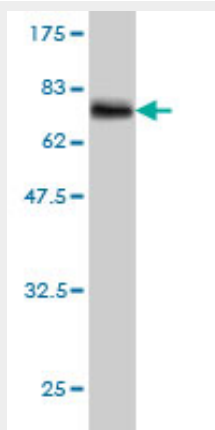

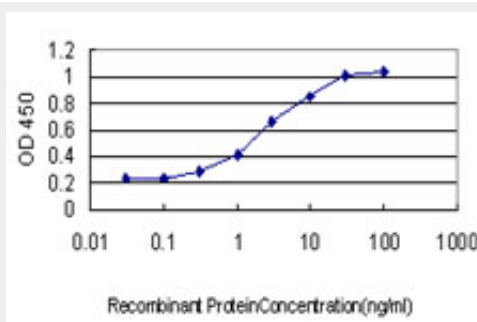
VP572 Antibody (monoclonal) (M01) - Images
