Function

Substrate-recognition component of the SCF (SKP1-CUL1-F-box protein)-type E3 ubiquitin ligase complex (PubMed:26171402). Promotes degradation of interleukin-22 receptor subunit IL22RA1 in resting and IL22-stimulated conditions by facilitating its ubiquitination (PubMed:26171402). Functions as a cell growth suppressor (PubMed:26171402).

Tissue Location

Ubiquitously expressed.

FBXW12 Antibody (C-term) Blocking peptide - Background

Members of the F-box protein family, such as FBXW12, are characterized by an approximately 40-amino acid F-box motif. SCF complexes, formed by SKP1 (MIM 601434), cullin (see CUL1; MIM603034), and F-box proteins, act as protein-ubiquitin ligases. F-box proteins interact with SKP1 through the F box, and they interact with ubiquitination targets through other protein interaction domains (Jin et al., 2004 [PubMed 15520277]). [supplied by OMIM].
