Function

Participates in the organization of endoplasmic reticulum- plasma membrane contact sites (EPCS) with pleiotropic functions including STIM1 recruitment and calcium homeostasis. Constitutive tether that co-localize with ESYT2/3 tethers at endoplasmic reticulum- plasma membrane contact sites in a phosphatidylinositol lipid-dependent manner. Pre-marks the subset of phosphatidylinositol 4,5-bisphosphate (PI(4,5)P2)-enriched EPCS destined for the store operated calcium entry pathway (SOCE).

Cellular Location

Endoplasmic reticulum membrane; Single-pass membrane protein. Cell membrane; Peripheral membrane protein. Note=Localizes to endoplasmic reticulum-plasma membrane contact sites (EPCS). Anchored at the ER, PM binding is mediated via GRAM domain and phosphatidylinositol lipid interaction. Localizes to distinct EPCS than GRAMD1A
