Name ZUP1 ([HGNC:21224](#))

Function

Deubiquitinase with endodeubiquitinase activity that specifically interacts with and cleaves 'Lys-63'-linked long polyubiquitin chains. Shows only weak activity against 'Lys-11' and 'Lys-48'-linked chains (PubMed:29476094, PubMed:29563501, PubMed:29576528). Plays an important role in genome stability pathways, functioning to prevent spontaneous DNA damage and also promote cellular survival in response to exogenous DNA damage (PubMed:29576527, PubMed:29576528). Modulates the ubiquitination status of replication protein A (RPA) complex proteins in response to replication stress (PubMed:29563501).

Cellular Location

Cytoplasm. Nucleus. Note=Mostly present in the nuclear fraction. Localizes to DNA lesions.
