In hippocampal neurons, regulates dendritic and spine growth and synaptic transmission.

Cellular Location

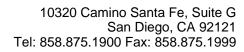
Nucleus, nucleolus {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q9D945}. Chromosome. Note=Cell-permeable protein. 22 hours after injection in the hippocampal area CA1, internalized by most cells at the injection site (By similarity). Localizes at the chromosome periphery during mitosis (PubMed:20813266) {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q9D945, ECO:0000269|PubMed:20813266}
