Function

Part of the small subunit (SSU) processome, first precursor of the small eukaryotic ribosomal subunit. During the assembly of the SSU processome in the nucleolus, many ribosome biogenesis factors, an RNA chaperone and ribosomal proteins associate with the nascent pre- rRNA and work in concert to generate RNA folding, modifications, rearrangements and cleavage as well as targeted degradation of pre- ribosomal RNA by the RNA exosome. Its dissociation from the complex determines the transition from state pre-A1 to state pre-A1* (PubMed:34516797<a href="http://www.uniprot.org/citations/34516797" target="_blank"

Neuroguidin is an EIF4E (MIM 133440)-binding protein thatinteracts with CPEB (MIM 607342) and functions as a translational regulatory protein during development of the vertebrate nervous system (Jung et al., 2006 [PubMed 16705177]).
