Palmitoyltransferase that could catalyze the addition of palmitate onto various protein substrates (By similarity). Palmitoyltransferase for HTT and GAD2. May play a role in Mg(2+) transport.

Golgi apparatus membrane {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q9CWU2}; Multi-pass membrane protein. Cytoplasmic vesicle membrane {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q9CWU2}; Multi-pass membrane protein. Note=Low extracellular Mg(2+) induces increase in Golgi and in post-Golgi vesicles. {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q9CWU2}
