Functions as an activator of the E3 ubiquitin protein ligase ITCH in the ubiquitination of the CXCL12-activated CXCR4 receptor. Thereby, triggers CXCR4 endocytosis and desensitization, negatively regulating the CXCL12/CXCR4 signaling pathway.

Cellular Location

Early endosome membrane; Single-pass type I membrane protein. Late endosome membrane; Single-pass type I membrane protein. Recycling endosome membrane; Single-pass type I membrane protein. Cell membrane; Single-pass type I membrane protein. Note=Enriched in endosomes compared to the cell membrane.

Tissue Location

Prominently expressed in muscle.
