This gene belongs to the chemokine-like factor genesuperfamily. This family of genes encodes multi-pass membraneproteins that are similar to both the chemokine and thetransmembrane 4 superfamilies of signaling molecules. Alternatetranscriptional splice variants of this gene, encoding differentisoforms, have been characterized.
