Function

Specific regulator of miRNA biogenesis. Binds, via the C3H1- type zinc finger domains, to the binding motif 5'-GCAGCGC-3' on microRNA pri-MIR143 and negatively regulates the processing to mature microRNA.

Cellular Location

Nucleus.
