Synonyms C5orf18, DP1, TB2

Function

Plays an essential role in heart function and development by regulating the organization and function of the sarcoplasmic reticulum in cardiomyocytes.

Cellular Location

Endoplasmic reticulum membrane; Multi-pass membrane protein. Sarcoplasmic reticulum membrane {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q60870}; Multi-pass membrane protein. Note=Localizes to endoplasmic reticulum tubular network (PubMed:23969831). In cardiomyocytes, localizes to the junctional sarcoplasmic reticulum membrane which is closely tethered to the cell membrane and contractile machinery (By similarity) {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q60870, ECO:0000269|PubMed:23969831}

Tissue Location

Expressed in heart (at protein level) (PubMed:32075961). Expressed in circumvallate papillae and testis (PubMed:16720576).
