Function

Ras proteins bind GDP/GTP and possess intrinsic GTPase activity. Plays an important role in the tumor-like growth properties of embryonic stem cells.

Cellular Location Cell membrane; Lipid-anchor; Cytoplasmic side

Tissue Location Expressed in several undifferentiated mouse embryonic stem cell lines.
