Function

Regulator of microtubule dynamic that has microtubule bundling activity (PubMed:17105200, PubMed:19633818). Required for embryo implantation; possibly by regulating beta-catenin (By similarity). Also required for decidualization via regulation of beta- catenin (PubMed:30667362).

Cellular Location

Cytoplasm, Cytoplasm, cytoskeleton

Tissue Location

Expressed in endometrium during the mid-secretory phase (LH + 7) (at protein level).
