### **Function**

Acts as an inhibitor of mitochondrial fission. Interacts with MFF and prevents DNM1L recruitment to mitochondria, promoting a more fused mitochondrial network.


# **Cellular Location**

Cytoplasm, cytosol {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q9D4W2}. Mitochondrion outer membrane {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q9D4W2}. Note=Predominantly localizes to the cytosol, with a minor fraction at the outer mitochondrial membrane {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:Q9D4W2}

### **Tissue Location**

Enriched in the pancreatic beta cell and the testis and is expressed at low levels in other tissues tested
