Target/Specificity

The synthetic peptide sequence used to generate the antibody AP6990b was selected from the C-term region of human SELL. A 10 to 100 fold molar excess to antibody is recommended. Precise conditions should be optimized for a particular assay.

Format

Peptides are lyophilized in a solid powder format. Peptides can be reconstituted in solution using the appropriate buffer as needed.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 6 months. For long term storage store at -20°C.

Function

Calcium-dependent lectin that mediates cell adhesion by binding to glycoproteins on neighboring cells (PubMed:<a href="http://www.uniprot.org/citations/12403782"

target="_blank">12403782, PubMed:28489325, PubMed:28011641). Mediates the adherence of lymphocytes to endothelial cells of high endothelial venules in peripheral lymph nodes. Promotes initial tethering and rolling of leukocytes in endothelia (PubMed:12403782, PubMed:<a href="http://www.uniprot.org/citations/28011641"

Cellular Location

Cell membrane; Single-pass type I membrane protein

SELL Antibody (C-term) Blocking Peptide - Background

SELL is a cell surface component that is a member of a family of adhesion/homing receptors which play important roles in leukocyte-endothelial cell interactions. The molecule is composed of multiple domains: one homologous to lectins, one to epidermal growth factor, and two to the consensus repeat units found in C3/C4 binding proteins.
