Description

All three isoforms of GRO are CXC chemokines that can signal through the CXCR1 or CXCR2 receptors. The GRO proteins chemoattract and activate neutrophils and basophils. Recombinant human GRO- γ is a 7.9 kDa protein consisting of 73 amino acids including the ' ELR' motif common to the CXC chemokine family that bind to CXCR1 or CXCR2.

BiologicalActivity

Determined by its ability to chemoattract 293 transfected CXCR2 cells using a concentration range of 10-100 ng/ml.

Authenticity

Verified by N-terminal and Mass Spectrometry analyses (when applicable).

Endotoxin

Endotoxin level is $<0.1 \text{ ng}/\mu\text{g}$ of protein ($<1\text{EU}/\mu\text{g}$).

Protein Content

Verified by UV Spectroscopy and/or SDS-PAGE gel.
