IL-1 α is a non-secreted proinflammatory cytokine produced in a variety of cells including monocytes, tissue macrophages, keratinocytes and other epithelial cells. Both IL-1 α and IL-1 β binds to the same receptor and has similar if not identical biological properties. These cytokines have a broad range of activities including, stimulation of thymocyte proliferation, by inducing IL-2 release, B-cell maturation and proliferation, mitogenic FGF-like activity and the ability to stimulate the release of prostaglandin and collagenase from synovial cells. However, whereas IL-1 β is a secreted cytokine, IL-1 α is predominantly a cell-associated cytokine. Recombinant rat IL-1 α is a 17.7 kDa protein containing 155 amino acid residues.

Biological Activity

The ED₅₀ as determined by the dose-dependent proliferation of murine D10S cells is < 0.005 ng/ml, corresponding to a specific activity of > 2 x 10⁸ units/mg.

Authenticity

Verified by N-terminal and Mass Spectrometry analyses (when applicable).

Endotoxin

Endotoxin level is <0.1 ng/ μ g of protein (<1EU/ μ g).

Protein Content

Verified by UV Spectroscopy and/or SDS-PAGE gel.
