Biotinylated Myt1-T495 Phospho Peptide - Protein Information**Name** PKMYT1**Synonyms** MYT1**Function**

Acts as a negative regulator of entry into mitosis (G2 to M transition) by phosphorylation of the CDK1 kinase specifically when CDK1 is complexed to cyclins (PubMed:9268380, PubMed:9001210, PubMed:10504341, PubMed:10373560). Mediates phosphorylation of CDK1 predominantly on 'Thr-14'. Also involved in Golgi fragmentation (PubMed:9268380, PubMed:9001210). May be involved in phosphorylation of CDK1 on 'Tyr-15' to a lesser degree, however tyrosine kinase activity is unclear and may be indirect (PubMed:9268380, PubMed:9001210).

Endoplasmic reticulum membrane; Peripheral membrane protein. Golgi apparatus membrane; Peripheral membrane protein
