Function

[Somatostatin-14]: Inhibits the secretion of pituitary hormones, including that of growth hormone/somatotropin (GH1), PRL, ACTH, luteinizing hormone (LH) and TSH. Also impairs ghrelin- and GnRH- stimulated secretion of GH1 and LH; the inhibition of ghrelin- stimulated secretion of GH1 can be further increased by neuronostatin.

Tissue Location

In the pancreas, somatostatin is expressed in delta cells of the islets of Langerhans. In the stomach, it is expressed in parietal cells of oxyntic mucosa and in the small intestine, it is found in the villus (at protein level) (PubMed:18753129). Neuronostatin is expressed in the pancreas in delta cells of the islets of Langerhans, as well as in the stomach, in parietal cells of oxyntic mucosa and in the small intestine, in the villus (at protein level) (PubMed:18753129).
